Tasting Notes

Opens with jammy plum aromas. Hints of rose petal, boysenberry and earthiness on the nose. Brambly black fruit flavors with notes cherry and cinnamon, all converging into a round, luscious finish

Estate Bassi Ranch Vineyard

Our estate Bassi Ranch Vineyard stands apart, pitched along steep slopes just 1.2 miles from the Pacific Ocean in Avila Beach. This wine represents our first estate-bottled Pinot Noir from this vineyard. The 2013 vintage is comprised of eight clones planted to 14.4 acres on the estate, specifically: Dijon 113, Dijon 114, Dijon 115, Wädenswil 2A, Pommard 4, Pommard 5, Dijon 667, and Dijon 777.

Winemaking

The fruit was hand-harvested on a block-by-block basis over a period extending from August 5 to October 8. Half of the lots were fermented with native yeasts to layer in natural complexity. The lots were punched down three times daily for balanced extraction. After fermentation, the wine was aged for 11 months in French oak barrels (50% new).
